## This funding will be used to

- Ensure that each student is meeting the National Minimum Standard (NMS) for their year level.
- Provide targeted support for individuals who are at risk of not achieving or are not achieving the National Minimum Standard in Literacy and Numeracy.

### Expected Outcomes:

- Maintaining the percentage of students at NMS or above in Literacy and Numeracy for students in Year 3 & Year 5.

## Our initiatives include

- Build and strengthen teacher capacity in explicit instruction.
- Implement additional support programs (Literacy & Numeracy) for students in Prep, Years 1, 2, 3 and 4 who are identified as at risk.
- Review student performance data in 5 weekly intervals.
- Continue to implement direct and explicit instruction programs in Literacy and Numeracy.

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Provide additional Teacher Aide hours to provide support for identified students to run intervention support programs in reading and numeracy. **\$8,798**
- Engage a teacher to co-ordinate, deliver and monitor reading and numeracy programs. **\$4,000**
